CODE OF CONDUCT

The Wilmette Wings Soccer Club ("WWSC") was formed to "teach the fundamental skills and techniques of the sport of soccer" and a primary objective of the Club is "to foster good sportsmanship, fellowship, team spirit, personal achievement, responsibility and character development", as stated in the WWSC By-Laws.

The WWSC Board of Directors, in discharging its responsibility to "establish rules governing membership and conduct of the [Wing's] soccer programs" has implemented a set of procedures that will allow coaches, trainers, managers or other members of the Club to address actions or deeds that negatively impact on the achievement of the Wings purpose cited above.

As a parent and as a player, by my signature below, I have read and accept the following Wings procedures governing my conduct while a member of the WWSC:

- Any action, deed or event initiated by a player or member of the WWSC that is deemed as constituting unsportsmanlike conduct or does not promote the objectives of the Club as stated above, will be reported to the Board in writing within seven (7) days by a coach, trainer, manager or other member. If the Board agrees with the filing, it will issue a letter of warning to the player or member within seven (7) days.
- If a subsequent action, deed or event occurs and a report is filed, the Board of Directors, by a majority vote, may require the player or member to resign from the WWSC, effective immediately.
- If the player or member receiving such notification disagrees with the action taken by the Board, they may submit a letter stating their position and ask for reconsideration. This request will be reviewed at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.
- If a final notice requiring resignation is issued, the WWSC will refund, on a pro rata basis, any fees remaining for the current year.
